## AN ACT

Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
Statutes, in registration of vehicles, further providing for
registration and certificate of title required; in licensing
of drivers, further providing for carrying and exhibiting
driver's license on demand; and, in inspection of vehicles,
further providing for operation of vehicle without official
certificate of inspection.

- 8 This act may be referred to as the Forgetful Driver
- 9 Forgiveness Act.
- 10 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 11 hereby enacts as follows:
- 12 Section 1. Section 1301 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 13 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:
- 14 § 1301. Registration and certificate of title required.
- 15 \* \* \*
- 16 <u>(e) Exceptions.--</u>
- 17 (1) No person charged with violating subsection (a)
- shall be convicted if fewer than 30 days have elapsed from
- 19 the expiration of the person's valid vehicle registration and
- 20 <u>the person:</u>

1	(i) produces at the headquarters of the police
2	officer who demanded to see the person's vehicle
3	registration, within 10 days of the demand, a vehicle
4	registration valid in this Commonwealth; or
5	(ii) if a citation has been filed, produces at the
6	office of the issuing authority, within 10 days of the
7	filing of the citation, a vehicle registration valid in
8	this Commonwealth.
9	(2) The exception under paragraph (1) does not apply if
10	the person, in addition to being charged with a violation of
11	subsection (a), is charged with another offense committed at
12	the same time and place.
13	Section 2. Section 1511(b) of Title 75 is amended to read:
14	§ 1511. Carrying and exhibiting driver's license on demand.
15	* * *
16	(b) Production to avoid penalty
17	(1) No person shall be convicted of violating this
18	section or section 1501(a) (relating to drivers required to
19	be licensed) if <u>fewer than 30 days have elapsed from the</u>
20	expiration of the person's valid driver's license and the
21	person:
22	[(1)] $\underline{\text{(i)}}$ produces at the headquarters of the police
23	officer who demanded to see the person's license, within
24	[15] $\underline{10}$ days of the demand, a driver's license valid in
25	this Commonwealth [at the time of the demand]; or
26	[(2)] <u>(ii)</u> if a citation has been filed, produces at
27	the office of the issuing authority, within [15] $\underline{10}$ days
28	of the filing of the citation, a driver's license valid
29	in this Commonwealth [on the date of the citation].
30	(2) The exception under this subsection does not apply

- 1 <u>if the person, in addition to being charged with a violation</u>
- of subsection (a) or section 1501(a), is charged with another
- 3 offense committed at the same time and place.
- 4 Section 3. Section 4703(b)(11) of Title 75 is amended and
- 5 the section is amended by adding a subsection to read:
- 6 § 4703. Operation of vehicle without official certificate of
- 7 inspection.
- 8 \* \* \*
- 9 (a.1) Prohibition.--
- 10 (1) No person shall be convicted of violating subsection
- 11 (a) if fewer than 30 days have elapsed from the expiration of
- 12 the valid certificate of inspection issued under this chapter
- for the vehicle being operated and the vehicle owner:
- (i) produces at the headquarters of the police
- officer who demanded the vehicle owner or operator to
- display an official certificate of inspection for the
- vehicle being operated, within 10 days of the demand, a
- 18 valid certificate of inspection issued under this chapter
- 19 for the vehicle; or
- 20 (ii) if a citation has been filed, produces at the
- office of the issuing authority, within 10 days of the
- 22 <u>filing of the citation</u>, a valid certificate of inspection
- 23 <u>issued under this chapter for the vehicle.</u>
- 24 (2) The exception under this subsection does not apply
- 25 <u>if the person, in addition to being charged with a violation</u>
- of subsection (a), is charged with another offense committed
- 27 at the same time and place.
- 28 (b) Exceptions.--Subsection (a) does not apply to:
- 29 \* \* \*
- 30 (11) A motor vehicle being operated by the vehicle owner

1	after the expiration of a valid certificate of inspection
2	under this chapter while enroute to an inspection station
3	where an appointment for inspection has been scheduled[,
4	provided that such operation occurs no later than ten days
5	after the expiration of a valid certificate of inspection
6	issued under this chapter]. The exception under this
7	paragraph does not apply if the person, in addition to being
8	charged with a violation of subsection (a), is charged with
9	another offense committed at the same time and place.

11	Section 4. This act shall take effect January 1, 2018.
