## AN ACT

Amending the act of June 2, 1915 (P.L.736, No.338), entitled, as reenacted and amended, "An act defining the liability of an employer to pay damages for injuries received by an employe 1 2 3 in the course of employment; establishing an elective 4

schedule of compensation; providing procedure for the 5

prescribing penalties," in additional coverages, further providing for the definition of "employe."

- 9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 10 hereby enacts as follows:
- 11 Section 1. Section 601(a) of the act of June 2, 1915
- 12 (P.L.736, No.338), known as the Workers' Compensation Act, is
- 13 amended by adding a clause to read:
- 14 Section 601. (a) In addition to those persons included
- 15 within the definition of the word "employe" as defined in
- 16 section 104, "employe" shall also include:
- 17 \* \* \*
- 18 (2.1) a person who suffers injury or death as a direct
- 19 result of rendering emergency care, first aid or rescue at the
- scene of an emergency and meets all of the following while 20

- 1 <u>rendering the emergency care, first aid or rescue:</u>
- 2 (i) is a member of a volunteer ambulance corps;
- 3 (ii) is operating within the person's scope of practice; and
- 4 (iii) is not officially on duty as a member of a volunteer
- 5 <u>ambulance corps;</u>
- 6 \* \* \*
- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
