- 2 § 8101. Scope of chapter.
- 3 This chapter relates to insurance coverage for
- 4 <u>electrocardiograms</u> for students participating in or desiring to
- 5 participate in an athletic activity.
- 6 § 8102. Definitions.
- 7 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
- 8 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 9 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 10 "Athletic activity." As defined under section 2 of the
- 11 <u>Sudden Cardiac Arrest Prevention Act.</u>
- 12 <u>"Electrocardiogram." A medical test</u> which results in a
- 13 graphic record of heart muscle activity showing the variations
- 14 in electric force which trigger the contraction of the heart in
- 15 order to diagnose heart disease.
- 16 "Health care provider." A person, corporation, facility,
- 17 <u>institution or other entity licensed</u>, certified or approved by
- 18 the Commonwealth to provide health care or professional medical
- 19 services. The term includes, but is not limited to, a physician,
- 20 chiropractor, optometrist, professional nurse, certified nurse-
- 21 midwife, podiatrist, hospital, nursing home, ambulatory surgical
- 22 center or birth center.
- 23 "Insurer." A health insurance entity licensed in this
- 24 Commonwealth to issue any individual or group health, sickness
- 25 or accident policy or subscriber contract or certificate that
- 26 provides medical or health care coverage by a health care
- 27 <u>facility or licensed health care provider that is offered or</u>
- 28 governed under any of the following:
- 29 (1) The act of May 17, 1921 (P.L.682, No.284), known as
- The Insurance Company Law of 1921, including section 630 and

- 1 Article XXIV thereof.
- 2 (2) The act of December 29, 1972 (P.L.1701, No.364),
- 3 <u>known as the Health Maintenance Organization Act.</u>
- 4 (3) The act of May 18, 1976 (P.L.123, No.54), known as
- 5 the Individual Accident and Sickness Insurance Minimum
- 6 Standards Act.
- 7 (4) Chapter 61 (relating to hospital plan corporations)
- 8 <u>or 63 (relating to professional health services plan</u>
- 9 <u>corporations</u>).
- 10 "Sudden Cardiac Arrest Prevention Act." The act of May 30,
- 11 2012 (P.L.574, No.59), known as the Sudden Cardiac Arrest
- 12 Prevention Act.
- 13 § 8103. Applicability.
- 14 This chapter shall not apply to the following policies:
- 15 (1) Accident only.
- 16 (2) Fixed indemnity.
- 17 <u>(3) Limited benefit.</u>
- 18 <u>(4) Credit.</u>
- 19 (5) <u>Dental</u>.
- 20 (6) Vision.
- 21 (7) Specified disease.
- 22 <u>(8) Medicare supplement.</u>
- 23 (9) CHAMPUS (Civilian Health and Medical Program of the
- 24 <u>Uniformed Services</u>) <u>supplement</u>.
- 25 (10) Long-term care or disability income.
- 26 <u>(11) Workers' compensation.</u>
- 27 (12) Automobile medical payment.
- 28 § 8104. Insurance coverage.
- 29 An insurer that provides health insurance coverage to a
- 30 student to which the Sudden Cardiac Arrest Prevention Act

- 1 applies shall also provide coverage for each electrocardiogram
- 2 required under the Sudden Cardiac Arrest Prevention Act. The
- 3 minimum coverage required shall include all costs associated
- 4 with each electrocardiogram.
- 5 Section 2. This act shall apply to a policy, contract or
- 6 certificate offered, issued or renewed by an insurer in this
- 7 Commonwealth on or after the effective date of this act.
- 8 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
