Section 5729(a)(10) of Title 3 of the 7 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: 8 § 5729. Misbranding of food. 9 (a) General rule.--A food shall be misbranded: * * * 10 11 (10) If it is a raw agricultural commodity bearing or 12 containing a pesticide chemical applied after harvest, unless 13 the shipping container of the commodity bears labeling which clearly and conspicuously declares the presence of the 14 15 chemical and the common or usual name and function of the 16 chemical. A clear and conspicuous declaration shall [not] be 17 required when the commodity is removed from the shipping 18 container and is held or displayed for sale at retail [in

accordance with the custom of the trade].

Section 2. This act shall take effect in 270 days.
