

- 13 (b.2) In addition to any other report required under this
- 14 section, no later than seventy-two (72) hours from an incident
- 15 of attempted suicide or committed suicide on school property, a
- 16 chief school administrator shall report the incident to the
- 17 office. The report under this subsection shall not reveal any
- 18 identifying information of a student and shall meet the
- 19 requirements under the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act

- 4 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
