Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania 1 Consolidated Statutes, in sexual offenses, further providing 2 for evidence of victim's sexual conduct. 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 4 hereby enacts as follows: 5 Section 1. Section 3104 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania 6 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: 7 § 3104. Evidence of victim's sexual conduct. 8 (a) General rule.--Evidence of specific instances of the 9 alleged victim's past sexual conduct, past sexual victimization, 10 allegations of past sexual victimization, opinion evidence of 11 the alleged victim's past sexual conduct, and reputation 12 evidence of the alleged victim's past sexual conduct shall not 13 be admissible in prosecutions [under this chapter] of any 14 offense listed in subsection (c) except evidence of the alleged 15 victim's past sexual conduct with the defendant where consent of 16 the alleged victim is at issue and such evidence is otherwise 17 admissible pursuant to the rules of evidence. 18

2	offer evidence of the alleged victim's past sexual conduct, past
3	sexual victimization, allegations of past sexual victimization,
4	opinion evidence of the alleged victim's past sexual conduct and

6	pursuant to subsection (a) shall file a written motion and offer
7	of proof at the time of trial. If, at the time of trial, the
8	court determines that the motion and offer of proof are

25	Section 4302 (relating to incest).

27	children), if the offense involved sexual contact with the
