Cenney Baserman and 9 10 the late James W. Baserman; and WHEREAS, A 1975 graduate of the Greater Johnstown Vocational-11 Technical High School, Sergeant Baserman served this country 12 13 with honor and distinction as a member of the United States Army; and 14 WHEREAS, A volunteer with the Oakland Volunteer Fire Company, 15 Sergeant Baserman was employed as an emergency medical 16 technician at East Hills Ambulance Service for more than 20 17 18 years; and
