

- 1 Amending Title 66 (Public Utilities) of the Pennsylvania

- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. The definition of "public utility" in section
- 7 1403 of Title 66 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is
- 8 amended and the section is amended by adding a definition to

- 10 § 1403. Definitions.
- 11 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
- 12 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 13 context clearly indicates otherwise:

- 15 "Private operating nonutility." A homeowners association, as
- 16 defined by section 528(c) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986
- 17 (Public Law 99-514, 26 U.S.C. § 528(c)), which collects money
- 18 from an owner or manager of a homeowners association property

- 1 and then remits that money to a wastewater utility or water
- 2 distribution utility on behalf of the owner or manager.
- 3 "Public utility." Any electric distribution utility, natural
- 4 gas distribution utility, small natural gas distribution
- 5 utility, steam heat utility, wastewater utility or water
- 6 distribution utility in this Commonwealth that is within the
- 7 jurisdiction of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission. The
- 8 term includes a private operating nonutility.

- 10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
