

AN ACT

1 Repealing the act of May 20, 1921 (P.L.939, No.328), entitled
2 "An act to provide for the disposition of all drugs which are
3 introduced in the evidence of any trial for the illegal
4 possession or sale of same.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. The act of May 20, 1921 (P.L.939, No.328),
8 entitled "An act to provide for the disposition of all drugs
9 which are introduced in the evidence of any trial for the
10 illegal possession or sale of same," is repealed:

11 [AN ACT

12 To provide for the disposition of all drugs which are introduced
13 in the evidence of any trial for the illegal possession or
14 sale of same.

15 Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That all drugs offered in
16 evidence in the trial of any cause in this Commonwealth
17 involving illegal sale or possession of such drugs, shall be
18 confiscated by the district attorney of the county in which said

1 trial takes place.

2 Section 2. The district attorney of the county of this
3 Commonwealth, who shall thus confiscate such drugs, is hereby
4 authorized to deliver such drugs to the State Department of
5 Health or to any other legally constituted health board of any
6 county of this Commonwealth, as in his discretion he may deem
7 fit.]

8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
