## A RESOLUTION

- Designating September 7, 2019, as "Great Lakes-St. Lawrence River Appreciation Day" in Pennsylvania. 1

- 3 WHEREAS, The Great Lakes system, including Lake Erie, Lake
- Huron, Lake Ontario, Lake Michigan, Lake Superior and the St. 4
- Lawrence River, is a globally significant resource and 5
- ecosystem, holding 21% of the world's surface freshwater; and 6
- 7 WHEREAS, The Great Lakes and St. Lawrence River provide
- drinking water to more than 48 million Americans and Canadians 8
- and supply 56 billion gallons of water per day for municipal, 9
- 10 agricultural and industrial use; and
- WHEREAS, On September 7, 2012, by signing a revised Great 11
- 12 Lakes Water Quality Agreement, the United States and Canada
- reaffirmed their commitment to binational cooperation "to 13
- 14 restore, protect, and enhance the water quality of the Great
- Lakes to promote the ecological health of the Great Lakes 15
- 16 basin"; and
- WHEREAS, An abundant supply of clean, affordable water is 17

- 1 essential to support a healthy population, a thriving economy
- 2 and a well-functioning ecosystem; and
- 3 WHEREAS, As the major source of water for communities located
- 4 within the Great Lakes basin, the Great Lakes system is a vital
- 5 resource in which all the region's residents share a common
- 6 interest; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The Great Lakes system is an economic powerhouse for
- 8 the region, supporting industries including shipping,
- 9 agriculture, technology, manufacturing, recreation and tourism;
- 10 and
- 11 WHEREAS, The waters and shoreline of the Great Lakes system
- 12 provide exceptional habitat for thousands of species of native
- 13 mammals, birds, amphibians, fish and plants; and
- 14 WHEREAS, The Great Lakes basin is home to numerous beaches,
- 15 parks, forests, harbors, marinas, piers, lighthouses, boardwalks
- 16 and islands that provide recreational opportunities for
- 17 swimming, hiking, surfing, boating, kayaking, canoeing, fishing,
- 18 hunting, photography, wildlife watching and more; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Lake Erie is among Pennsylvania's most valuable
- 20 natural resources and has extraordinary economic value for this
- 21 Commonwealth; and
- 22 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania's Lake Erie coastal region provides a
- 23 home for an estimated 250,000 Pennsylvania residents and more
- 24 than 3,000 jobs, Presque Isle State Park, which attracts 4
- 25 million visitors who spend an estimated \$76.9 million annually,
- 26 a tourism and recreation industry that contributes more than \$65
- 27 million to Pennsylvania's economy, harbors and marinas that
- 28 support a \$71 million annual recreational boating industry and a
- 29 growing steelhead fishery that generates nearly \$10 million in
- 30 expenditures and \$6 million in value-added activity in Erie

- 1 County; and
- 2 WHEREAS, People greatly value the opportunity to live, work
- 3 and play in areas near waters that are vibrant, beautiful and
- 4 life-sustaining; and
- 5 WHEREAS, The region's environment, economy and people rely on
- 6 the clean healthy waters of the Great Lakes and St. Lawrence
- 7 River; therefore be it
- 8 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate
- 9 September 7, 2019, as "Great Lakes-St. Lawrence River
- 10 Appreciation Day" in Pennsylvania; and be it further
- 11 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives encourage all
- 12 residents to learn about the importance of the Great Lakes and
- 13 St. Lawrence River to the economy and the environment of this
- 14 Commonwealth.
