

- The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Title 15 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 8 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 9 § 1111. Eliqibility for receipt of State resources.
- 10 (a) Conditions. -- A domestic business corporation or a
- foreign business corporation with 200 or more employees in this 11
- Commonwealth shall not be eliqible for a State contract, State 12
- funding or a State grant if the corporation: 13
- 14 (1) has violated the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938
- 15 (52 Stat. 1060, 29 U.S.C. § 201 et seq.) within the previous
- 16 five years;
- (2) is found quilty of an unfair labor practice in this 17
- 18 Commonwealth within the previous five years;

1	(3) has violated the act of August 15, 1961 (P.L.987,
2	No.442), known as the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act,
3	within the previous five years; or
4	(4) fails to submit to the Department of State current
5	bylaws of the corporation, which must provide for a
6	corporation having a governing board, that at least 20% of
7	the members of the governing board of the corporation are
8	current employees of the corporation and are elected by the
9	employees of the corporation.
10	(b) Applicability This section shall not apply if the
1	condition described in subsection (a)(1), (2) or (3) occurred
12	prior to the effective date of this section.
13	Section 2. This act shall apply to the following:
L 4	(1) A State contract entered into or renewed on or after
L5	the effective date of this act.

- 16 (2) State funding approved or otherwise made on or after the effective date of this act. 17
- (3) A State grant approved on or after the effective 18 date of this act. 19
- Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 20
