- Section 1. The definitions of "employee" and "facility" in 11
- section 103 of the act of October 7, 2010 (P.L.484, No.70), 12
- known as the Adult Protective Services Act, are amended to read: 13
- Section 103. Definitions. 14
- The following words and phrases when used in this act shall 15
- have the meanings given to them in this section unless the 16
- context clearly indicates otherwise: 17
- * * * 18
- "Employee." An individual who is employed by a facility. The 19
- 20 term includes:

- 1 (1) A contract employee who has direct contact with 2 residents or unsupervised access to their personal living 3 quarters.
 - (2) A person who is employed or who enters into a contractual relationship to provide care to an adult for monetary consideration in the adult's place of residence.
- 7 (3) A person who is employed by a public, private or parochial school.
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- "Facility." The term includes, but is not limited to:
- 11 (1) An assisted living residence as defined in section
- 12 1001 of the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known as
- 13 the [Public Welfare] Human Services Code.
- 14 (2) A domiciliary care home as defined in section
- 15 2202-A of the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known
- 16 as The Administrative Code of 1929.
- 17 (3) A home health care agency as defined in section
- 18 802.1 of the act of July 19, 1979 (P.L.130, No.48), known as
- 19 the Health Care Facilities Act.
- 20 (4) An intermediate care facility for people with mental
- 21 retardation.
- 22 (5) A long-term care nursing facility as defined in
- 23 section 802.1 of the act of July 19, 1979 (P.L.130, No.48),
- 24 known as the Health Care Facilities Act.
- 25 (6) An older adult daily living center as defined in
- 26 section 2 of the act of July 11, 1990 (P.L.499, No.118),
- 27 known as the Older Adult Daily Living Centers Licensing Act.
- 28 (7) A personal care home as defined in section 1001 of
- 29 the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the
- 30 [Public Welfare] <u>Human Services</u> Code.

- 1 (8) An organization or group of people that uses public 2 funds and is paid, in part, to provide care [and] <u>or</u> support
- 3 to adults in a licensed or unlicensed setting, including a
- 4 public, private or parochial school.
- 5 (9) A residential treatment facility.
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- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
