AN ACT

Amending the act of July 17, 1968 (P.L.368, No.181), entitled "An act creating a regional intergovernmental compact agency 2 for the planning, conservation, utilization, development, 3 management and control of water and related natural resources 4 of the Susquehanna river basin, for the improvement of 5 navigation, preservation of amenities, reduction of flood 6 damage, regulation of water quality, control of pollution, 7 development of water supply, hydroelectric energy, fish and 8 wildlife habitat and public recreational facilities, and 9 other purposes, and defining the functions, powers and duties 10 of such agency; providing for the relation of such regional agency to other agencies of and in the state government; and 11 12 for related purposes," providing for negotiation of early 13 termination or withdrawal. 14 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 15 hereby enacts as follows: 16 Section 1. The act of July 17, 1968 (P.L.368, No.181),

referred to as the Susquehanna River Basin Compact Law, is 18

amended by adding a section to read: 19

Section 4.1. (a) For a period of five years from the 20

effective date of this section, the Governor shall negotiate 21

with the other signatory parties to the compact either an 22

agreement for an early termination of the compact or the 23

- 1 concurrence of the other signatory parties to the immediate
- 2 withdrawal of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania as a signatory
- 3 party to the compact.
- 4 (b) The Governor shall no later than September 1 of each
- 5 year during the five-year period under subsection (a), file a
- 6 written report with the General Assembly that specifies the
- 7 <u>efforts of the Governor to comply with the duty imposed by</u>
- 8 <u>subsection (a). The report shall include the names of persons</u>
- 9 contacted, dates when the contacts were made and the status of
- 10 each contact.
- 11 (c) If, at the conclusion of the five-year period under
- 12 subsection (a), the signatory parties have not agreed to an
- 13 early termination of the compact or have failed to concur with
- 14 the immediate withdrawal of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 15 from the compact, the Governor shall notify the commission in
- 16 accordance with section 1.5 of the compact of the Commonwealth
- 17 of Pennsylvania's intention to terminate the compact at the end
- 18 of the initial period.
- 19 (d) Upon termination of the compact or withdrawal of the
- 20 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania from the compact by concurrence of
- 21 the signatory parties, the Secretary of the Commonwealth shall
- 22 transmit a notice to the Legislative Reference Bureau for
- 23 publication in the Pennsylvania Bulletin that states the date of
- 24 the early termination or withdrawal from the compact.
- 25 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
