8	hereby enacts as follows:
9	Section 1. The act of April 6, 1951 (P.L.69, No.20), known
10	as The Landlord and Tenant Act of 1951, is amended by adding a
11	section to read:
12	Section 106. Effect of Declaration of Disaster Emergency
13	(a) It shall be deemed unlawful for a landlord to do any of the
14	following during a disaster emergency declared by the Governor
15	<u>under 35 Pa.C.S. § 7301(c) (relating to general authority of</u>
16	Governor) due to an epidemic or pandemic:
17	(1) Evict or attempt to evict a tenant unemployed, separated
18	from employment or unable to find employment as a result of the
19	declaration of disaster emergency.
20	(2) Without the express consent of the tenant, enter the

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1 <u>leased premises for purposes of showing the premises to</u>

2 prospective buyers or tenants.

- 3 (b) A landlord found to be in violation of this section
- 4 shall be subject to a penalty of not less than five hundred
- 5 <u>dollars (\$500) per occurrence.</u>
- 6 (c) This section shall apply only to residential leaseholds
- 7 and not to commercial leaseholds.
- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
