21	(f.1) Referendum exception for disaster emergency
22	Notwithstanding subsection (f), a school district may, without

seeking voter approval under subsection (c), increase the rate of a tax levied for the support of the public schools by more than the index during the duration of the proclamation of disaster emergency issued by the Governor on March 6, 2020, published at 50 Pa.B. 1644 (March 21, 2020), including during the duration of any renewal of the state of disaster emergency. * * *
