

AN ACT

1 Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343, No.176), entitled,
2 as amended, "An act relating to the finances of the State
3 government; providing for cancer control, prevention and
4 research, for ambulatory surgical center data collection, for
5 the Joint Underwriting Association, for entertainment
6 business financial management firms, for private dam
7 financial assurance and for reinstatement of item vetoes;
8 providing for the settlement, assessment, collection, and
9 lien of taxes, bonus, and all other accounts due the
10 Commonwealth, the collection and recovery of fees and other
11 money or property due or belonging to the Commonwealth, or
12 any agency thereof, including escheated property and the
13 proceeds of its sale, the custody and disbursement or other
14 disposition of funds and securities belonging to or in the
15 possession of the Commonwealth, and the settlement of claims
16 against the Commonwealth, the resettlement of accounts and
17 appeals to the courts, refunds of moneys erroneously paid to
18 the Commonwealth, auditing the accounts of the Commonwealth
19 and all agencies thereof, of all public officers collecting
20 moneys payable to the Commonwealth, or any agency thereof,
21 and all receipts of appropriations from the Commonwealth,
22 authorizing the Commonwealth to issue tax anticipation notes
23 to defray current expenses, implementing the provisions of
24 section 7(a) of Article VIII of the Constitution of
25 Pennsylvania authorizing and restricting the incurring of
26 certain debt and imposing penalties; affecting every
27 department, board, commission, and officer of the State
28 government, every political subdivision of the State, and
29 certain officers of such subdivisions, every person,
30 association, and corporation required to pay, assess, or
31 collect taxes, or to make returns or reports under the laws
32 imposing taxes for State purposes, or to pay license fees or
33 other moneys to the Commonwealth, or any agency thereof,

1 every State depository and every debtor or creditor of the
2 Commonwealth," in general budget implementation, repealing
3 provisions relating to Joint Legislative Air and Water
4 Pollution Control and Conservation Committee; and making a
5 related repeal.

6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
7 hereby enacts as follows:

8 Section 1. Section 1799.9-E of the act of April 9, 1929
9 (P.L.343, No.176), known as The Fiscal Code, is repealed:

10 [Section 1799.9-E. Joint Legislative Air and Water Pollution
11 Control and Conservation Committee.

12 (a) Termination.--The Joint Legislative Air and Water
13 Pollution Control and Conservation Committee established under
14 the act of January 19, 1967 (1968 P.L.1022, No.448), entitled,
15 "An act creating a Joint Legislative Air and Water Pollution
16 Control and Conservation Committee, providing for the terms and
17 appointment of members and for organization of the committee and
18 employment of personnel, providing for study of air and water
19 pollution laws and their enforcement, providing for information
20 and assistance from other agencies of government, and making an
21 appropriation," shall terminate July 1, 2021.

22 (b) (Reserved).]

23 Section 2. Repeals are as follows:

24 (1) The General Assembly finds that the repeal under
25 paragraph (2) is necessary to effectuate this act.

26 (2) Section 24(1) and (2) of the act of June 28, 2019
27 (P.L.173, No.20), are repealed.

28 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
