Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343, No.176), entitled, as amended, "An act relating to the finances of the State 2 government; providing for cancer control, prevention and 3 research, for ambulatory surgical center data collection, for 4 the Joint Underwriting Association, for entertainment 5 business financial management firms, for private dam 6 financial assurance and for reinstatement of item vetoes; 7 providing for the settlement, assessment, collection, and 8 lien of taxes, bonus, and all other accounts due the 9 Commonwealth, the collection and recovery of fees and other 10 money or property due or belonging to the Commonwealth, or 1.1 any agency thereof, including escheated property and the 12 proceeds of its sale, the custody and disbursement or other 13 disposition of funds and securities belonging to or in the 14 possession of the Commonwealth, and the settlement of claims 15 against the Commonwealth, the resettlement of accounts and 16 appeals to the courts, refunds of moneys erroneously paid to 17 the Commonwealth, auditing the accounts of the Commonwealth 18 and all agencies thereof, of all public officers collecting 19 moneys payable to the Commonwealth, or any agency thereof, 20 and all receipts of appropriations from the Commonwealth, 21 authorizing the Commonwealth to issue tax anticipation notes 22 to defray current expenses, implementing the provisions of 23 section 7(a) of Article VIII of the Constitution of 24 Pennsylvania authorizing and restricting the incurring of 25 certain debt and imposing penalties; affecting every 26 department, board, commission, and officer of the State 27 government, every political subdivision of the State, and 28 certain officers of such subdivisions, every person, 29 association, and corporation required to pay, assess, or 30 collect taxes, or to make returns or reports under the laws 31 imposing taxes for State purposes, or to pay license fees or 32 other moneys to the Commonwealth, or any agency thereof, 33

- every State depository and every debtor or creditor of the Commonwealth," in general budget implementation, repealing 1
- provisions relating to Joint Legislative Air and Water 3
- Pollution Control and Conservation Committee; and making a 4 related repeal. 5
- The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6
- hereby enacts as follows: 7
- Section 1. Section 1799.9-E of the act of April 9, 1929 8
- (P.L.343, No.176), known as The Fiscal Code, is repealed: 9
- [Section 1799.9-E. Joint Legislative Air and Water Pollution 10
- Control and Conservation Committee. 11
- (a) Termination. -- The Joint Legislative Air and Water 12
- Pollution Control and Conservation Committee established under 13
- the act of January 19, 1967 (1968 P.L.1022, No.448), entitled, 14
- "An act creating a Joint Legislative Air and Water Pollution 15
- Control and Conservation Committee, providing for the terms and 16
- appointment of members and for organization of the committee and 17
- employment of personnel, providing for study of air and water 18
- pollution laws and their enforcement, providing for information 19
- and assistance from other agencies of government, and making an 20
- appropriation," shall terminate July 1, 2021. 21
