## A RESOLUTION

Recognizing October 2, 2020, as "Manufacturing Day" in 1 Pennsylvania. 2 WHEREAS, The manufacturing industry directly adds more than 3 \$70 billion in value to Pennsylvania's economy every year; and 4 WHEREAS, The manufacturing sector is a leading contributor to 5 gross State product at 12%; and 6 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania manufacturers sell more than \$31 7 billion worth of goods overseas annually, representing 90% of 8 9 all State exports; and WHEREAS, More than 560,000 Pennsylvania workers are employed 10 in the manufacturing industry; and 11 WHEREAS, Millions of additional Pennsylvania jobs are 12 directly sustained by manufacturing in supply chains, 13 distribution networks, warehousing and logistics; and 14 WHEREAS, Manufacturing jobs have above-average wages and 15 benefits, with average annual income of more than \$61,000, 44% 16 higher than nonmanufacturing sectors; and 17
