AN ACT

1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania

2 Consolidated Statutes, in inchoate crimes, prohibiting the

3 possession of firearm at polling place.

- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 914. Possession of firearm at polling place.
- 9 (a) Offense defined. -- Except as provided under subsections
- 10 (c) and (d)(2), a person commits an offense if the person:
- 11 (1) knowingly possesses a firearm in any building, real
- 12 property or parking area of a polling place holding an
- 13 <u>election;</u>
- 14 (2) knowingly possesses a firearm in any building, real
- 15 property or parking area of a polling place holding an
- 16 election with the intent of using the firearm in the
- 17 <u>commission of a crime; or</u>
- 18 (3) knowingly causes a firearm to be used in the

- 1 <u>commission of a crime in any building, real property or</u>
- 2 parking area of a polling place holding an election.
- 3 (b) Grading.--The following apply:
- 4 (1) An offense committed under subsection (a) (1) shall
- 5 <u>constitute a misdemeanor of the third degree.</u>
- 6 (2) An offense committed under subsection (a) (2) or (3)
- 7 <u>shall constitute a misdemeanor of the first degree.</u>
- 8 (c) Exceptions. -- Subsection (a) shall not apply to the
- 9 <u>lawful performance of official duties by an officer, agent or</u>
- 10 employee of the Federal Government, the Commonwealth or a
- 11 political subdivision of the Commonwealth who is authorized to
- 12 <u>engage in or supervise the prevention, detection, investigation</u>
- 13 or prosecution of any violation of law.
- 14 (d) Posting of notice. -- The following apply:
- 15 (1) Notice of the provisions of subsections (a), (b) and
- 16 (c) shall be posted conspicuously at each public entrance of
- 17 <u>a building where a polling place is located during an</u>
- 18 <u>election</u>.
- 19 (2) A person shall not be convicted of an offense under
- 20 <u>subsection (a)(1) or (2) if the polling place fails to meet</u>
- the notice requirements under paragraph (1).
- 22 (e) Definitions. -- As used in this section, the following
- 23 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 24 <u>subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 25 <u>"Election." A general, municipal, special or primary</u>
- 26 <u>election as authorized under the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333,</u>
- 27 No.320), known as the Pennsylvania Election Code.
- 28 "Firearm." Any weapon, including a starter gun, which will
- 29 or is designed to expel a projectile or projectiles by the
- 30 action of an explosion, expansion of gas or escape of gas. The

- 1 term does not include any device designed or used exclusively
- 2 <u>for the firing of stud cartridges, explosive rivets or similar</u>
- 3 <u>industrial ammunition</u>.
- 4 "Polling place." The room provided in each election district
- 5 for voting during an election.
- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
