16	purposes of this subsection, the term "local]
17	(2) As used in this subsection, the following words and
18	phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this

2 "Local law enforcement [agency"] agency." The term shall 3 include the Pennsylvania State Police when conducting 4 unlawful gambling enforcement and prevention activities in a 5 municipality which does not have a municipal police 6 department and in which the Pennsylvania State Police provide 7 the municipality with primary police coverage.

8 <u>"Unlawful gambling." The term shall include an offense</u> 9 <u>under 18 Pa.C.S. §§ 5513 (relating to gambling devices,</u> 10 <u>gambling, etc.), 5543 (relating to animal fighting) and 5544</u> 11 <u>(relating to possession of animal fighting paraphernalia).</u> 12 * * *

13 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
