5	(c) Participation Participation in the program by a law
6	enforcement officer or sheriff shall be voluntary.
7	(d) Surrender of firearm The following shall apply:
8	(1) An individual may surrender a firearm to a
9	participating law enforcement officer or sheriff within this
10	Commonwealth.
11	(2) An individual who surrenders a firearm under this
12	section shall remain anonymous and shall not be subject to
13	prosecution for the possession of the firearm.
14	§ 6193. Powers and duties of Attorney General.
15	(a) Administration The Attorney General shall administer
16	the program in conjunction with the commissioner, a law
17	enforcement officer or a sheriff.
18	(b) Rules and regulations The Attorney General shall
19	promulgate rules and regulations necessary to effectuate the
20	implementation of the program. Rules and regulations promulgated
21	under this subsection may include guidelines:
22	(1) For a law enforcement officer or sheriff
23	participating in the program to:
24	(i) Designate when and where a firearm may be
25	surrendered by an individual.
26	(ii) Coordinate with community groups within its
27	jurisdiction.

12	(a) Establishment The Pennsylvania Gun Buyback Program			
13	Fund is established in the State Treasury.			
14	(b) Contents The fund shall consist of:			
15	(1) Money appropriated, transferred or otherwise made			
16	available to the fund from the General Fund.			
17	(2) Donations made to the fund from private businesses,			
18	charities and individuals.			
19	(3) Other money, including assets, seizures and			
20	forfeitures collected by law enforcement officers or sheriffs			
21	and authorized by law for deposit in the fund.			
22	(c) Continuing appropriation The money in the fund and the			
23	interest accruing on the money is appropriated to the Office of			
24	Attorney General on a continuing basis to carry out this			
25	subchapter.
