- Section 1. Section 67A07 of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania 7
- Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read: 8
- § 67A07. Audio recording or video recording policies. 9

- (c) Authorization .-- Notwithstanding any other provision of 11
- law to the contrary, a law enforcement agency may use technology 12
- that facilitates the review of a video recording when 13
- investigating incidents involving bodily injury that create a 14
- substantial risk of death or cause serious, permanent 15
- disfigurement or protracted loss or impairment of the function 16
- of any bodily member or organ. To utilize the technology under 17
- this subsection, the commissioner, chief of police, the chief or 18

- 1 head of a law enforcement agency or a designee thereof must
- 2 provide written or digital authorization.
- 3 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
