AN ACT

Amending the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), entitled "An act relating to tax reform and State taxation by codifying and enumerating certain subjects of taxation and imposing taxes thereon; providing procedures for the payment, collection, administration and enforcement thereof; providing for tax credits in certain cases; conferring powers and imposing duties upon the Department of Revenue, certain employers, fiduciaries, individuals, persons, corporations and other entities; prescribing crimes, offenses and penalties," in sales and use tax, further providing for form of returns.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:
Section 1. Section 216 of the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No. 2), known as the Tax Reform Code of 1971, is amended to read: Section 216. Form of Returns.--(a) The returns required by section 215 shall be on forms prescribed by the department, and shall show such information with respect to the taxes imposed by this article as the department may reasonably require.
(b) The department shall ensure that the form prescribed by
the department under this section includes the following statement:

Anyone can heal and save lives. Yes, I would like to register as an organ and tissue donor.
(c) The statement under subsection (b) shall include a box that an applicant may check to request inclusion in the national donate life registry. If the box is checked, the department shall automatically submit the information for inclusion in the national donate life registry.
(d) As used in this section, the term "national donate life registry" shall mean any of the following:
(1) A tax-exempt, nonprofit donor registry.
(2) A donor registry identified by the federally designated organ procurement organizations serving this Commonwealth. Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
