AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, in registration of vehicles, further providing for
3 vehicles exempt from registration; and, in licensing of
4 drivers, further providing for persons exempt from licensing.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Sections 1302 and 1502 of Title 75 of the
8 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended by adding
9 paragraphs to read:

10 § 1302. Vehicles exempt from registration.

11 The following types of vehicles are exempt from registration:

12 * * *

13 (2.3) Any implement of husbandry, trailer or semitrailer
14 used for agricultural operations and operated by an
15 individual upon highways between a farm that is the
16 individual's residence and a school that is hosting an annual
17 agriculture-related educational event for the purpose of
18 participating in that event, provided that the distance

1 between the individual's residence and the site of the event
2 does not exceed 25 miles.

3 * * *

4 § 1502. Persons exempt from licensing.

5 The following persons are not required to obtain a driver's
6 license under this chapter:

7 * * *

8 (6) Any individual 14 years of age or older may operate
9 an implement of husbandry, trailer or semitrailer not to
10 exceed 11 feet in width on a roadway for the purpose of
11 driving that implement between sunrise and sunset to an
12 annual agriculture-related educational event hosted by a
13 school, provided that the distance between the individual's
14 residence and the site of the event does not exceed 25 miles.

15 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
