In the event of a tie vote for office of president judge in a court which elects its president judge, the Supreme Court shall appoint as president judge one of the judges receiving the highest number of votes. \* \* \*

First of all, let me just express my gratitude to the gentleman, Mr. Godshall, for agreeing to have his bill held over until today so that we can consider this amendment.

Mr. Speaker, this amendment is very simple in nature. What it does is it would amend the Constitution to simply say that in counties or in court systems with three or more judges, that the senior judge or the Chief Justice would be elected by a vote of the judges rather than simply become Chief Justice or president judge based on seniority. This issue was brought to my attention by a former House member, Ralph Pratt, who is my predecessor who is now a judge in Lawrence County, and he has indicated to me that a number of his colleagues on common pleas courts around the State have indicated the need for this.

I would appreciate the support of the House on this amendment.

I am receiving correspondence from the Business Roundtable and receiving correspondence from some of my brothers and sisters in the union movement about a potential gas tax increase, Mr. Speaker.

I do not know about you, Mr. Speaker, although I have a substantial reservoir of respect for your intellectual acumen, but I could not, if my life depended on it, conjecture as to exactly what is going to be in this gas tax proposal. So it is amazing that people outside this building who have a firm perspective in favor of a gas tax increase can remain so committed to a program and we do not have any idea, those of us on this side of the aisle - those of us on this side of the aisle including my very good friends - we do not know exactly what is going to be in the maintenance formula; we do not know exactly which projects are going to be included in the effort. And for the Pennsylvania Business Roundtable or any other group in our State to aggressively advocate a gas tax increase when a trucking company in Lebanon County tells us this morning that 22 percent of their profits will be eviscerated by a gas tax increase as perceived by their accountants last week, I think it is really premature for people to come out in favor of something when we do not have a copy of it, Mr. Speaker.

So I would like you to lend your good offices to trying to get us a copy of the gas tax increase that Governor Ridge and his chieftains are proposing. I am sure that by tomorrow you will be able to help us, and I am respectfully suggesting that you put your good offices in that area. Thank you very much, Mr. Speaker.
