## TESTIMONY ON FALSE ABUSE CHARGES

## OUTLINE

- 1) Filing of Inappropriate Reports By Psychologist
  - a) Dr. Addis Report dated August 24th, 1990
  - b) Dr. Addis Report dated August 12th, 1992
  - c) Boiler Plate Reporting To The Courts
- 2) False Sexual Abuse Charges
  - a) Holly Denman's Claim used against the baby-sitter, (placing him at risk of 30 years to life imprisonment) for the purpose of moving out of her father's home which is located in a remote area
  - b) False allegations are quick, efficient, and brutal. The only requirement of the mother is to turn the child against the father, (which is usually quite easy), rehearse a few lines of testimony, and let Children & Youth Services rubber stamp the charges.
  - c) The cost of defense against false charges sometimes exceeds over \$200,000.00 \*according to Private Investigator Larry Daly of Seattle, Washington, with attorneys fees starting at \$25,000.00 minimum. Daly also cites that there is an estimated 125,000 men falsely accused each year. Besides the financial devastation, 80% lose their jobs or get laid off.
