Our program includes monthly networking opportunities, group health insurance as well as other group purchasing service arrangements. A membership directory and community buyers guide. Business Seminars and individual business counseling through SCORE, Senior Core of Retired Executives.

80% of our membership is made up of small businesses with employment numbers ranging from 1-10 employees. These are businesses evolved in the service industry, retailing, manufacturing and numerous other programs.
