Dear Chairman Caltagirone:

My name is Deborah Donahue; I have served as the Executive Director of Domestic Violence Services of Cumberland & Perry Counties (DVS/CP) for the past ten years. I am submitting this written testimony to urge you to support HB59, which will provide a dedicated funding stream for domestic violence programs across Pennsylvania

Since 2002, DVS/CP has been faced with state and federal cutbacks totaling over \$35,000. Due to these cutbacks, DVS/CP had to eliminate two fulltime positions. One position was a fulltime counselor/advocate, which provided on-going supportive services for victims of domestic violence. The elimination of this position has caused a delay for clients in receiving crisis counseling, safety planning, and assistance with developing a goal plan to escape their abuse.

The second position that DVS/CP eliminated was a fulltime public education specialist, reducing the number of prevention education programs presented to schools and the community. These programs are vital as a means to reach victims of domestic violence and to educate the community about the impact of violence against women and children.

In addition, DVS/CP has delayed maintenance projects at our emergency shelter such as an upgrade to our security system and replacement of corroded entrance doors. This has a direct impact on the safety of our residents and staff members.

Without an increase in funding, programs like DVS/CP will be forced to make further staff reductions and clients will be unable to gain immediate access to vitally needed services.
